

Connecticut State Latin Day Chariot Design Contest Rules

Each school may enter only one chariot. Upon arrival, please take your chariot to the softball field.

Judging Categories:

- Latin name 25%
- Authenticity 25%
- Craftsmanship 25%
- Attractiveness 25%

Requirements:

1. Each chariot must have the school's name attached and clearly visible. *Unidentified chariots will be disqualified.*
2. Each chariot must have two wheels with a tire rim of $\frac{3}{4}$ inch or more.
3. Each chariot must have a Latin name with a classical reference, *e.g., Currus Ignis Vulcani.*
4. The front piece must be a minimum of 24 inches from the floor board to the top rim.
5. Each chariot must be built by students; chariots built in previous years may be reentered.
6. Each chariot must be sturdy, even though no one may ride in it. The yoke must be attached securely enough to enable the chariot to finish the race intact.
