

Connecticut State Latin Day *Tunica Contest*

Here are the rules:

1. The school's tunicas must be made for the school this year. They should follow the basic pattern for tunicas. They must cover each student decently and must be sewn on the sides. The school's tunicas must be indicative of the school. They must be alike or must fit into a theme for the school.
2. No tunic may cost more than \$15.00. Proof of cost should be available.
3. At least 50% of the school's students should be wearing the designed tunica.
4. The judging criteria will be:
 - a. Latin theme and logo on the tunica.
 - b. Care given to details of construction.
 - c. Overall appearance of the tunicas and the students.
 - d. Students' explanation of their tunicas.
